

RESOURCE BAG

1. **April Curriculum pages** - Parents, read through these before you engage your children in the monthly activities.
2. **Story pieces and backdrops** for our final story. These can be used while watching the God's Story video, or you can use them after you watch the video while retelling the story in your own words.
3. **Toddler Rhyme Cards** to go with Steph Peterson's video on the website. Watch and practice with your children.
4. **Art supplies for families with teens.** Use these items in connection with Steph Peterson's teen art video.
5. **Lament activity bag** - (glass bottle, funnel, strips of paper, and colored salt) Use your Lament curriculum pages for instructions
6. **Read-aloud book** for the whole family, *The Biggest Story*. For families with toddlers, you also have a board book about the Easter Story.
7. **'Party in a bag'** for celebration! (party hats, cupcake papers, cake mix, icing, sprinkles). Bake cupcakes and celebrate something special with your family.
8. **Holy Week box and instructions** for young children, to help them remember the story of Christ's death and resurrection.
9. **Holy Week liturgy** with a purple felt cross to remember the last week of Christ's life, death, and resurrection. (Use your Advent battery candles)
10. **Service Project:** two greeting cards to share with loved ones. Decide as a family who will receive a Celebration or Lament card. Send to someone to tell them your family celebrates them, and share some reasons why. Also, who do you know that may be grieving and would appreciate a kind word of comfort? Let everyone in the family contribute to both cards in some way. (such as expressing kind words, licking a stamp, writing the address, or coloring a picture). Pray for the recipients before sending the cards.
