## INTRO TO THIS MONTH'S THEME

The Christmas season is over and the season of Epiphany is at hand. The early church fathers recommended extending the gift of hospitality during this season of Epiphany. It reminds us how often God's presence is connected to hospitality in the scripture. This month we pray you will sense his presence as you open your home to others.

In September, you received a handout of the Apostles' Creed and your family talked about what a Christian believes. This month when you invite others into your home (or meet in another setting), plan to steer the conversation to a faith topic with your children present for the conversation. Ask your guests about their faith story and notice if your children are listening. We have real life spiritual heroes among us in our community. One of the gifts of hospitality is the mutual exchange between host and guest as we share our stories. This may be one of your favorite memories from your time in Growing Families.
