This month, in **Telling God's Story**, your family will tell the story of how the church continues to grow after watching God's Story part 1.

In part 2 this month, your family will also discuss all the places you have shared God's story. We've provided a world map and purple dots to help you. We would love to see pictures of your creative storytelling and your map.

The March Spiritual Practice is Spiritual Conversations, and you will have a chance to practice this at a special breakfast on Saturday, March 21st. We hope you enjoy all of the resources this month, and don't forget to let us know which parts were your family's favorites. Look for the following items in your bag: (we've noted the approximate time commitment for each activity).

1. **Family Conversation cards** to use around the table or any time you choose. **(2-3 minutes per card)**

2. **Creative tools to tell and interact with God's story:**

- A gold bag filled with story pieces
- paper Pentecost hats for children to wear during that part of the story
- A map of Paul's journeys
- Rhyme cards for toddlers and their families
- Art supplies for families with teens
- World map with purple dots

3. **March Curriculum pages** - Parents, read through these before you engage your children in the monthly activities. **(7 minutes)**

4. This month's book is **Make Room: A Child's Guide to Lent and Easter**. We've given you a guide to read the book in 3 parts. If you have a baby or toddler, you will receive the board book, **Make Space for Jesus**. Laura Alary writes both books.

6. **A snack** recipe and ingredients to help you celebrate the Lenten Season. It is a very simple recipe and your children will love it, we promise!
