

# RESOURCE BAG

## OCTOBER



As you open your bag, remember to create a comfortable rhythm. Find a regular time in your schedule to use this month's resources so children can anticipate your time together. *Remember, the goal is connection over perfection!*

Items in your bag:

1. **October curriculum pages** to put in your 3-ring binder. Parents, use the weekly suggestions and make a plan for what you can do.
2. **Sensory bin** for small hands to use after watching the God's Story video or during your family discussions.
3. **Story pieces and backdrops.** These can be used while watching the God's Story video, or you can use them after the video to retell the story in your own words.
4. **Toddler Rhyme Cards** to place in your plastic holder. Please watch the video with Steph Peterson on the website to find out how to use them.
5. **Plastic file folder with art supplies for families with teens.** Use these items in connection with Steph Peterson's video for teens and their families. She will lead your family through an art activity. This month, you will explore the devastating effect of separation from God's presence because of the Fall.
6. **A snack bag** of popcorn to pop and eat during Sabbath time or while watching God's Story video. For a special treat, sprinkle the bag of mixed candy into your popped popcorn.
7. **The Planting Values Board Game Jr.** is for families with young children to introduce value words.
8. The **Values Card Game** can be used with elementary-age children through adults. Instructions are included for both games.
9. **A Compass** to use with an Activity page.
10. **"A Legacy that Lasts: Preserving and Transferring Your Family Values".** A book for parents to begin discussing their family's value system. In February, Dr. Russell Hall will teach us more about the importance of instilling values in our children.
11. **Storage box.** Along with your resource bag, you received a storage box this month to contain all of your God's Story pieces. By April, this will fill up! Keep this ready to place new items each month.
