SEPTEMBER



As you open your bag, remember to create a comfortable rhythm. Find a regular time in your schedule to use this month's resources so children can anticipate your time together. Remember, the goal is connection over perfection!

Items in your bag:

1. **September pages** to put in your 3-ring binder. Parents, read the weekly suggestions and make a plan for what you can do.
2. **Play-Doh mats and Play-Doh** for small hands to use during your family discussions.
3. **Apostles Creed Cards** to use while discussing your shared belief system. This discipleship tool helps children form a Christian worldview at an early age.
4. **"Telling God's Story" Script, Creation Cards, and black felt** can be used with the video and story pieces to tell a new part of the story each month.
5. **Toddler Rhyme Cards and a plastic holder** to collect a different set of cards each month. Use these with the video featuring Steph Peterson on the website.
6. **A bag of snacks** to mix and eat during or after the Creation story.
7. **"The Garden, the Curtain and the Cross"** is a beautiful way to share the biblical narrative with your children and teens. Read this book aloud as a family.
8. **"God Gave Us Prayer"** is for families with small children only. You could read a section each night.
9. **Prayer Dice** are used during prayer time. Each person rolls the dice and uses the prayer cue on top of the dice.
10. **The Speaker-Listener Floor** will be used as you review the worksheet connected to Dr. Stratton's video on Communication.
